The villages are placed close the good fields in the lower lying areas. These areas are flooded to a greater or lesser extent every year. This year the flooding has been much worse than normally, last time it was as bad as this was during the great floods in 1996. The water came slowly, the communities had time to evacuate and rescue most of their belongings. There has been no casualties apart from one family who refused to leave and nobody has seen them since.</p>
